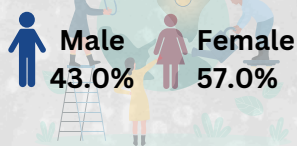


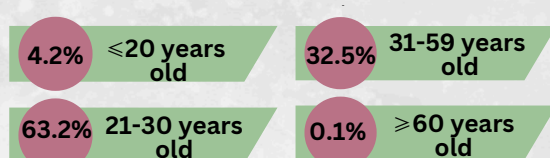

### AGE GROUP



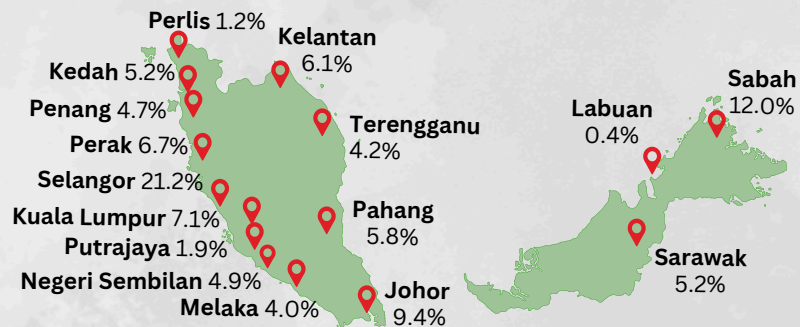

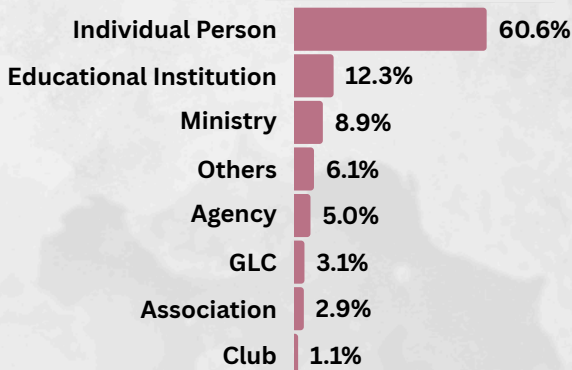

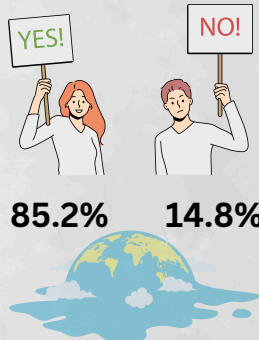

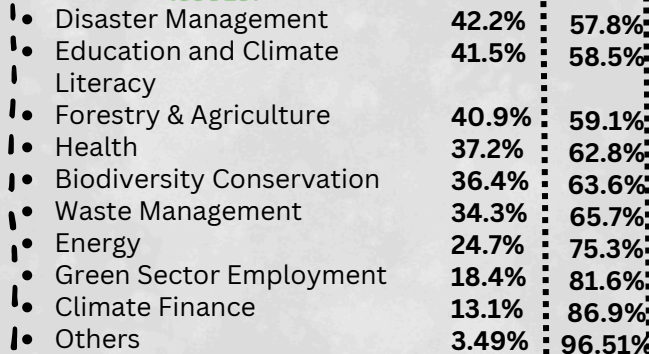

## WHICH SECTOR PLAYS THE MOST IMPORTANT ROLE IN ADDRESSING CLIMATE CHANGE ISSUES?



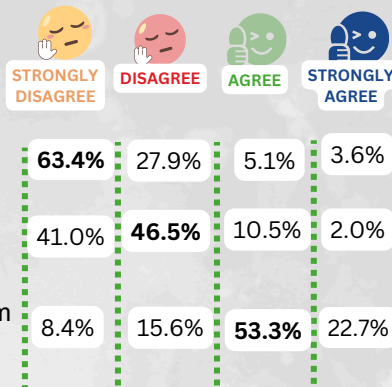

I lack experience and knowledge of climate change. I am not in a position to discuss its solutions.

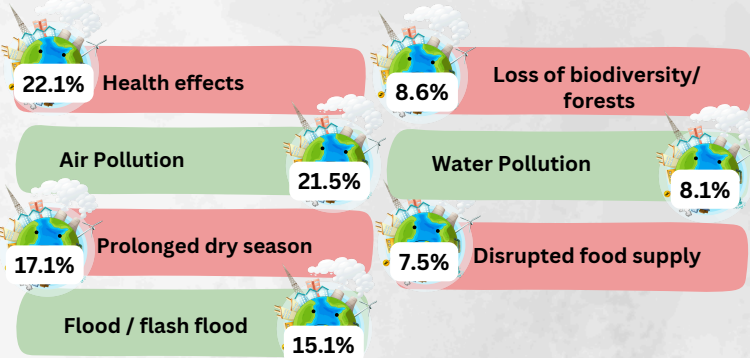
I am aware of climate change issues, but I am unsure how to get involved.
